**CET**. The event will look to the future of Global Education and will launch an 18-month process leading to the development of a new **European**



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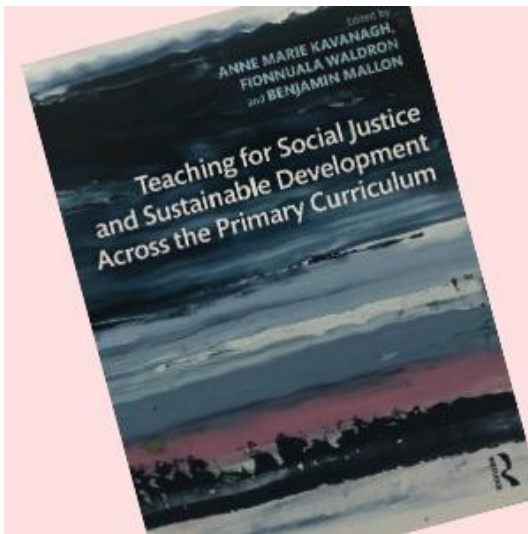

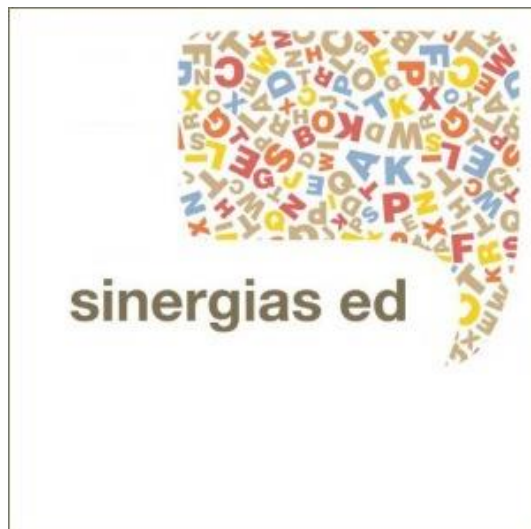
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### DERC seminar

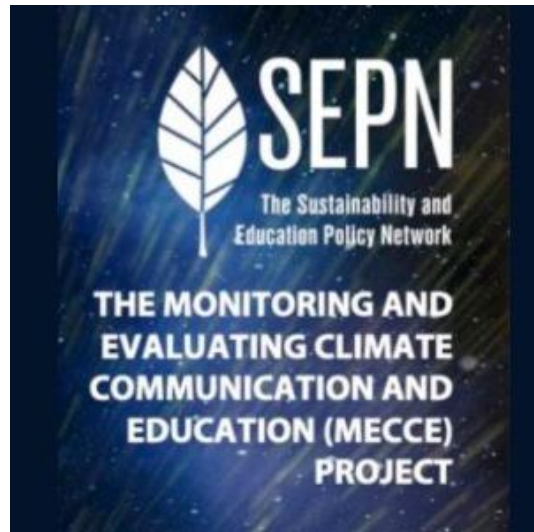


## Report

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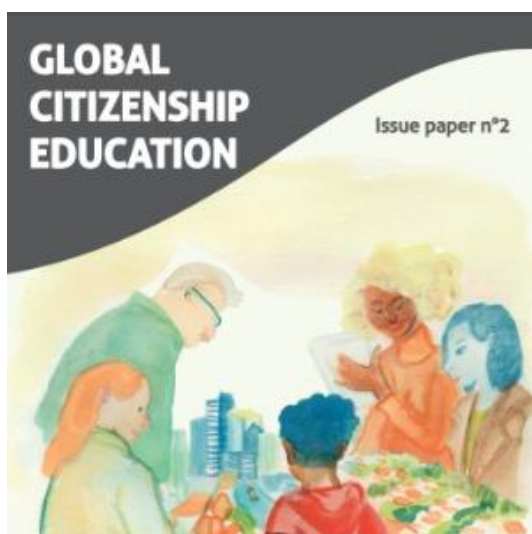


## **MECCE Project**
