

TEACHING METHODOLOGIES

This UC has 75 tutorial hours. The monitoring of the work developed by the student will be conducted through tutorial support provided by the teachers defined as the Advisors. This support includes:

- 1 - Guidance on the exploratory study about the theme of the Dissertation/Project Work/Training;
- 2 - The exposition of contents/relevant research methodologies and discussion with the student;
- 3 - Analysis and presentation of work within the sector/area of study throughout the year to prepare the Dissertation/Project Work/Training;

DEMONSTRATION OF THE COHERENCE BETWEEN THE TEACHING METHODOLOGIES AND THE LEARNING OUTCOMES

Given the objectives of the curricular unit of "Dissertation / Project Work / Training", it is structured using regular meetings between the student and the advisors. These meetings will clarify questions about all the work that is being developed. The preparation of the work and its subsequent submission and evaluation by a jury in the area, will allow the analysis if the goals and competences defined for this curricular unit were achieved or not.

EVALUATION METHODS

Assessment:

- Delivery of an original work, specially prepared for this purpose and developed under the guidance of one (or more) teachers (Advisors) - The preparation of the dissertation or project work or the training period are guided by PhD teachers or specialists of recognized merit, in the area in which the work is developed;
- Presentation and discussion in the presence of a jury appointed for this purpose, meeting the requirements of the legislation.
